



**5. CONSIDER APPROPRIATE ACTION ON THE AGREEMENT WITH THE DIBOLL YOUTH BASEBALL ASSOCIATION FOR USE OF BASEBALL FIELDS IN OLD ORCHARD PARK.**

Mr. McDuffie said the Diboll Youth Baseball Association never signed the agreement to provide an audit that would be paid by the city. Mr. Cassels said the next thing to do is to ask Diboll Youth Baseball Association to be at our next council meeting to answer some of these questions and sign the agreement. The Council agreed to ask the Diboll Youth Baseball Association to be at our next regular council meeting on September 14, 2009 and if no one response the City has other options that can be considered.

**6. DISCUSS THE CONTRACT AND THE ISSUE OF RECYCLING AND WEEKLY REFUSE PICKUPS IN THE CITY OF DIBOLL.**
