This item provides the opportunity to address the City Council on any matter whether or not it's posted on the agenda. However, in accordance with the Texas Open Meetings Act, Section 551.041, the Council cannot discuss, deliberate, or take any action on matters not listed on the agenda. At this time, the Council will receive citizen comments, and if necessary, may refer the matter to City staff for research, resolution or referral to Council on a future agenda.

Item #1: City Secretary, Melissa McCall, to present the Oath and Statement of Officer to the newly unopposed/appointed Mayor John C. McClain and City Council Members Lewis Ivey, Daniel Lopez and Charles Moses, Sr.

Item #2: Discuss and consider taking action to nominate and appoint the Mayor Pro Tem.

Item #3: Consent Agenda: All matters listed under 'Consent Agenda' are considered to be routine by the City Council and will be enacted by one motion. There will not be Discussion and action to consider an Ordinance Discussion and action to consider an Ordinance separate discussion of these items. If discussion is desired, that item will be removed from the consent agenda and will be considered separately.

Item #4: Discuss and consider taking action to approve Lufkin Daily News as the official newspaper for the City of Diboll, as the current official newspaper, The Diboll Free Press, is no long in operation.

Item #5: Discuss and consider taking action to consider amending the current City of Diboll Code of Ordinances, Chapter 9, section a., which states "*A notification of infraction based on evidence detected through the use of an automated traffic safety camera must be mailed to the registered owner of the vehicle within fourteen (14) days of the violation, or to the renter of a vehicle within fourteen (14) days of establishing the renter's name and address under subsection c.1. of this*

section.” Judge Julie Alston is requesting that this be amended to **thirty (30) days** of the violation, to be consistent with the State of Texas by-laws.

Item #6: Discuss and consider taking action to approve Economic Development Agreements for both Bonner Roofing and Metal, Inc. and Third General Stores, LLC, in accordance with Article III, §52a, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 380, Texas Local Government Code (“Chapter 380”), pursuant to which the City has the authority to make grants or loans of public funds for the public purposes of promoting local economic development and stimulating business and commercial activity within the City is in the best interests of the City.

Item #7: Consideration and approval of award of bids received on Neil Pickett Street Water Line Project, paid for by the TDA TxCDBG grant.

Item #8 Discuss, consider and adopt Resolution 2018-06-001 to designate authorized signators for the Texas CDBG Program Planning Contract No. 7217054

Item #9: Discuss, consider and approve Resolution 2018-06-002 adopting required CDBG Civil Rights policies.

Item #10: Discuss, consider and proclaim April as Fair Housing Month. This proclamation will help fulfill the Fair Housing activity obligations as required by the grant.



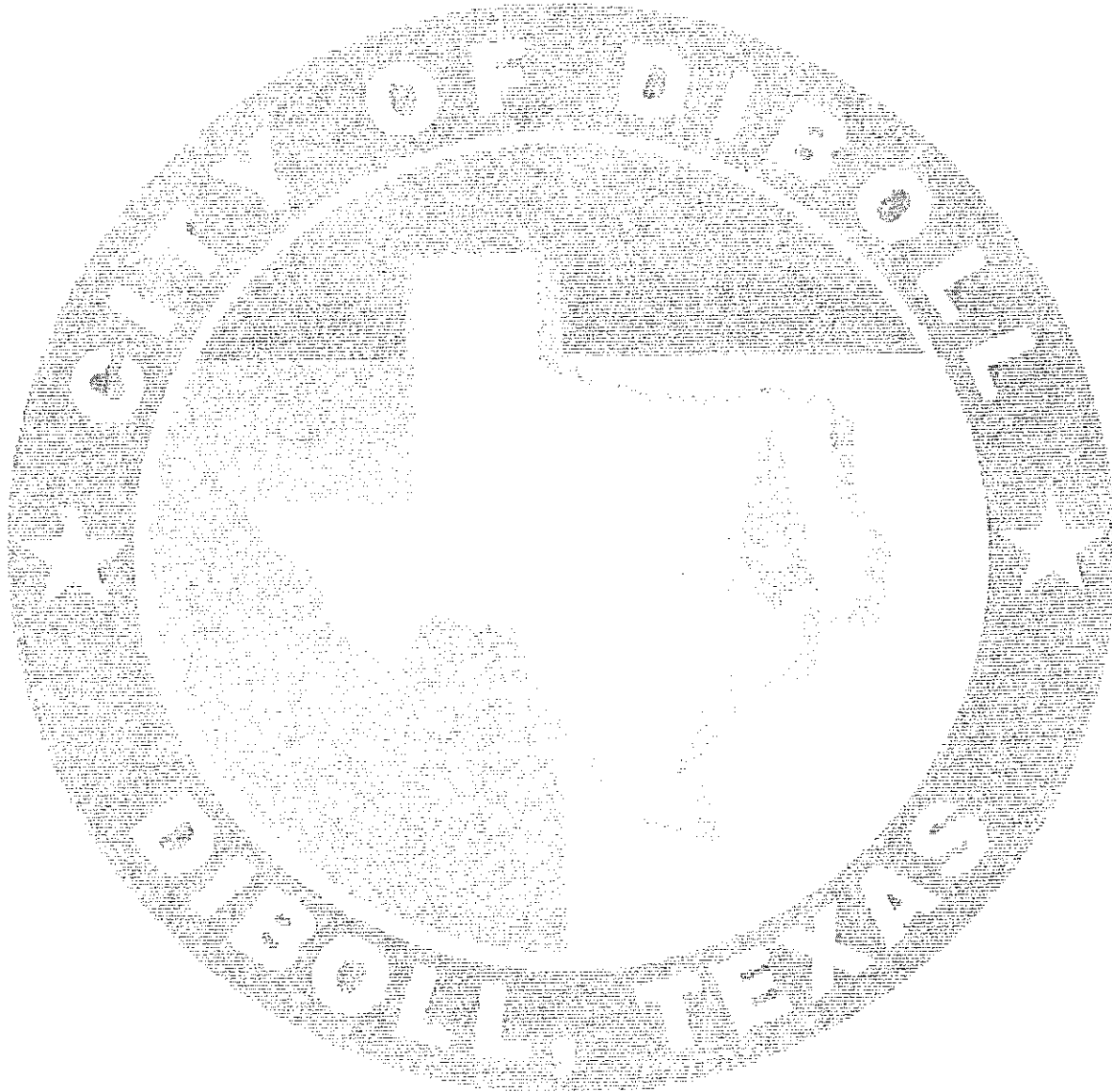
Adjournment
