

JUDGE'S STANDING ORDER NO. 21:

ANNUAL AMNESTY PLANS

IT IS ORDERED that a defendant who appears at the Court Clerk's window to plead "guilty" or "no contest" may have fees, fines, and/or costs removed or discounted during the annual amnesty period established by the Court.

IT IS ORDERED that the Clerk shall process a request for an installment (payment) plan from a person who appears at the Clerk's window during the annual amnesty period, provided the following guidelines are met:

PAYING ½ OF THE OUTSTANDING BALANCE

1. The defendant must pay half of the outstanding balance (minus any and all warrant fees) at the time of the request;
2. at the time of this payment plan request, the defendant shall complete and sign plea form(s) and an "Application for Payment Over Time of for an Extension to Pay"; and
3. the defendant shall then make installments at the rate of \$50.00 per month to begin the following month.


PAYING THE BALANCE IN FULL

IT IS ORDERED that if the defendant pays the outstanding balance in full, the Clerk shall remove any failure to appear fine, warrant fees, plus 20% from the outstanding fine amount before payment. Additionally, the Clerk will submit a Motion to Dismiss any pending VPTA and/or FTA charges to the Court.

DEFAULT ON INSTALLMENT PLAN

If the defendant defaults on the installment plan, **IT IS ORDERED** that the defendant will be scheduled for a show cause hearing.
